NO NUMBER CARDS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE FEIS. Competitors must print at home and bring with them to the Feis.

NO COOLERS AND NO OUTSIDE FOOD ARE PERMITTED IN THE VENUE! Food & beverages will be for sale in the venue. There is NO CAMPING in the venue; plenty of seating is available in the competition rooms and the cafeteria.

Dancing with heavy shoes on any floors other than stages throughout the venue is not permitted.

Any entry received after **May 9, 2026 at 6pm** will only be accepted with a \$25.00 Late Fee and any entry received on **May 11, 2026 until 6pm** will only be accepted with a \$50.00 Late Fee. Entries after cap of 600 is achieved will be notified of rejection. No entries will be accepted after **May 11, 2026 at 6pm**. Maximum Family Fee excludes Late Fee, Family Fee and Feisweb Fee. There is a \$15.00 change of entry fee, per competitor/per dance. No changes will be allowed after **May 11, 2026**. There will be no changes the day of the Feis allowed.

REFUND POLICY: There will be NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON due to the major financial investment incurred in planning the Feis, even for reasons due to illness or weather. We will not respond to requests for refunds.

PLEASE NOTE: Solo costumes are not permitted for Pre-Beginner, Beginner and Advanced Beginner competitions. Dancers in these competitions must wear school costumes.

- ❖ The Feis reserves the right to combine age groups in all levels in competitions with less than 5 entrants, or cap, split or cancel competitions if registration numbers are too low to run as a separate competition in all levels.
- ❖ Three Grades dancers on stage at one time for competitions Under 13 and under unless otherwise noted.
- ❖ Video or digital photography of any kind that has the capability of capturing a dancer's image while in motion is strictly forbidden, except in the Pre-Beginner, Beginner and Advanced Beginner categories.
- ❖ Female Adult dancers must wear black tights.

Solo awards will be given for soft and hard shoe dances. Boys & Girls combined. Absolutely **NO DANCE CHANGES** will be accepted day of Feis – **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP - This event is open to dancers aged 18 or older, who have not competed during the previous five (5) years, except as an Adult-level dancer. Ladies & Men Combined.

ADVANCED ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP - An Advanced Adult dancer is defined as anyone age 18 or older who has previously placed in the top 3 of a Prelim Championship or competed in Open Champ levels in the youth/&over levels regardless of when the competitor was active. Ladies & Men Combined.

OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS: Three rounds, hard shoe first. Choice of Reel (48 Bars) or Slip Jig (40 Bars); and Treble Jig (48 Bars) or Hornpipe (40 Bars). Set piece of own choice; Under 9 must dance Traditional Set. Rotation numbers will be drawn by computer prior to the day of the Feis. Solo awards will be given for soft and hard shoe dances. If less than 5 boys per competition, Feis committee may combine boys with the corresponding girls age group. Adult Championship (521) must dance a Traditional Set. Advanced Adult Championship (522) may perform a set of choice. Absolutely **NO DANCE CHANGES** will be accepted day of Feis – **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
