PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIP – ALL AGE GROUPS UNDER 14 WILL DANCE 3 AT A TIME IF STAGE IS 32x24 OR LARGER. ALL AGE GROUPS OVER 14 WILL DANCE 2 AT A TIME. CHOICE OF REEL (48 BARS) OR SLIP JIG (40 BARS), AND JIG (48 BARS) OR HORNPIPE (40 BARS). **Hard shoe first.**

Video recording is NOT permitted. Preliminary dancers who win three (3) 1st places in a calendar year, must move to Open Championships the following calendar year. When a third 1st place win is achieved over several calendar years, the dancer must move to Open Championships the following weekend.
