# Local Rules

1) Awards will be presented in proportion to the number of entries in each competition and to the degree of proficiency shown.

2) Carlene Stillson and the Stillson School of Irish Dance, The Town of Portland, and the Feis committee will not be held responsible for personal injury, loss of property, etc.

3) There will be no coolers allowed on the premises. Refreshments will be available at the feis.

4) Closing date for entries is July 13th, 2024. All entries received after that date are subject to a \$30 late fee per family. NO entries will be accepted after July 18th, 2024.

5) Competition numbers must be printed PRIOR to the feis. They will NOT be available the day of.

#### 6) The feis committee reserves the right to combine or split competitions based on the number of dancers.

7) Dance choices for Prelim and Open must be indicated on entry.

#### 8) NO VIDEO CAMERAS ALLOWED- except for pre-beginner, beginner, and advanced beginner categories.

9) All competitors must be pupils of a TCRG or ADCRG registered with members of CLRG.

## **Entries**

All entries must be submitted prior to July 13th, 2024. Entries submitted after this date are subject to a \$30 late fee. No entries will be accepted after July 18th, 2024. Changes made after July 13th and before July 18th will be accepted with a \$20 change fee. No changes will be accepted after July 18th, 2024. No entries will be accepted by phone or on the day of the feis.

#### Payment: After registering on FeisWeb all fees must be paid online.

#### Fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

If all fees are not paid at the time of registration, the entry will be deleted to free a spot for another dancer- no exceptions.

#### Adult Competitions:

\*Are classified as competitions for dancers who:
1. Has not taken Irish Dancing lessons as a juvenile and must be at least 18 years of age on January 1st, 2023

 May have taken lessons as a juvenile but have not competed in any competition, solo or teams, feisanna or Oireachtaisi, except competitions specifically designated for adults within the past 5 years, and must be at least 18 years of age as of January 1st, 2024.
