RULES AND REMINDERS

- 1. The Flynn Feis is a private event. Admission can be refused to any individual.
- 2. Our schedule will be posted on our social media channels (Facebook and Instagram) no later than the Wednesday before the feis. We will not have paper copies to distribute. Please follow our accounts for updates and changes!
- 3. Grade level solos may be combined at the discretion of the Feis committee when possible to have 5 dancers in competitions to allow for advancement. Championship competitions will not be combined regardless of entry numbers in order to award our perpetual trophies.
- 4. NO hard shoe practice in the hallways or on the gymnasium floors.
- 5. No camping allowed inside. Feel free to camp outside.

6. NO PHOTOGRAPHY OR VIDEOTAPING OF DANCING COMPETITIONS IS PERMITTED.

THE FEIS COMMITTEE, THE FLYNN SCHOOL, and ARCHBISHOP STEPINAC HIGH SCHOOL will not be held responsible for personal injury, property loss or damage. Destruction of FEIS property or rental property will be punishable by law.

ALL GRADE SOLOS WILL DANCE TWO STEPS (EXCEPT FIRST FEIS). No solo costumes are allowed in First Feis, beginner, and advanced beginner competitions. Skirt and blouse or school costumes only for these levels. Dancers need to be ready to start at least one hour prior to scheduled time.

FIRST FEIS (Competition: 900) - Open to anyone under 7 who has never taken formal lessons. One step in the Reel (122).

BEGINNER – A competitor who has not taken Irish Dancing from a registered teacher *prior* to Sept. 1st of the previous year. Dancer must move to Advanced Beginner the following year.

<u>ADULT CHAMPIONSHIP- COMPETITION # 600:</u> Adult championship competitions are confined to those aged 25 and over who have not competed except as an adult during the last 5 years. Men and women are combined. Choice of reel (48 bars) or slip jig (40 bars) and jig (48 bars) or hornpipe (40 bars) and a traditional set. (3 rounds)

<u>ADVANCED ADULT CONTEMPORARY SET - COMPETITION # 700:</u> Advanced Adult competition for those aged 25 and over who have not competed except as an adult during the last 5 years. Men and women are combined. This is to provide an opportunity for those dancers competing as an advanced adult at the North American Nationals to perform their contemporary set.

PRELIMINARY AND OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

Rotations will be computer-generated. Solo rounds will be awarded. Dancers will have a choice of Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (40 bars) and Jig (48 bars) or Hornpipe (40 bars). A- Reel/Jig B- Reel/Hornpipe C- Slip Jig/Jig D- Slip Jig/Hornpipe

<u>PRELIMINARY</u>: Open to competitors who have placed 1st in Prizewinner Reel or Slip Jig <u>and</u> Jig or Hornpipe. Girls and Boys are combined. Prelim dancers who win THREE 1st places in a calendar year, must move to Open the following calendar year. When a third 1st place win is achieved over several calendar years, the dancer must move to Open the following weekend. Dancers need to be ready to start at least one hour prior to scheduled time.
