The Feis is Registered and will be governed by the Rules of An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha (CLRG) and the IDTANA MidAtlantic Region, Inc. (<https://www.mid-atlanticregion.com>)

All dancers will dance two at a time. Adult competitions may not be combined with any other age groups in any category.

1. **SUBMIT** all entries online at www.feisweb.com.

2. **CLOSING DATE for entries without a late fee is October 18, 2024.** Starting October 19th a late fee of \$25.00 for entry is added. Effective October 21, a late fee of \$50 is add. Absolutely no late fees after October 21, 2024.
