Rialacha na Feise

1. Age as on 1st January 2025

- 2. Entries only accepted from teachers registered with An Coimisiun Le Rince Gaelacha
- 3. Objections must be lodged within one hour of commencement of the results of a competition and must be accompanied by a fee of €20.00

4. BUN, TUS, LAR, MEAN GRAD are open to ALL AREAS

- 5. Children competing in all ages in Bun and Tus competitions may only wear: Class costumes, Skirt and Blouse or appropriate Civilian Clothing. No low cut or off the shoulder tops or short tight skirts are permitted.
- 6. Bun Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age or grade or who have been upgraded. **Basic Steps** only.
- 7. Tus | Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age in Tus, Lar, Mean or Ard Grad or who have been upgraded.
- 8. In Tus Grad dancers may perform either basic steps or their first hard/difficult version of each dance. Steps in Tus Grad Heavy Jig and Hornpipe must be similar to those used in St. Patrick's Day and The Blackbird.
- 9. Lar Grad confined tyo dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age in Mead or Ard Grad.
- 10. Dancers may only perform a dance in Mean Grad if they have never won 1st prize for that dance in Mean or Ard Grad in that age or a higher age. However a dancer, who won a particular dance in a higher age in the previous year, may dance that dance again in Mean Grad in the next calendar year in their own or a higher age group. A dancer who wins a Preliminary Championship may not dance those dances in Mean Grad for the remainder of the calendar year.
- 11. Dances permitted in Rince Eadtrom: Reel, Light Jig, Slip Jig, or Single Jig.
- 12. Traditional Set Dances: St. Patrick's Day, The Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies, Jockey to the Fair, 3 Sea Captains.
- 13. Make-Up and false tan are not permitted in Bun and Tus Grad up to and including under 12 competitors.
- 14. Make-Up (including false eyelashes and face tan) will not be permitted for all age groups up to and including Under 10.
- 15. Dancers must perform to the following metronomic speeds: Bun Grad Reel 122-124, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 124, Heavy Jig 96, Hornpipe 144, Tus Grad-Reel 116-118, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 120, Heavy Jig 82, Hornpipe 130, Mean Grad Reel 113, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 113, Heavy Jig 73, Hornpipe 113, Traditional Set Dances (minimum) St. Patrick's Day 94, Blackbird 144, Job of Journeywork 138, Garden of Daisies 138, King of Fairies 130, Three Sea Captains 96, Jockey to the Fair 90.
- 16. With regard to toe movements No block, enpointe, stationary or moving will be allowed for all ages up to and including Under 12. However An Coimisiun Rule dancers who will compete under 13 from January 2026 may perform enpointe movements from September 2025.
- 17. The committee as far as practicable will provide a surface flooring suitable for dancing, however the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while onstage, or within the

- practice areas. The lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by a dancer and by his/her parent or guardian.
- 18. Any form of unauthorised photography which had the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, I Pad, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in all competitions.
- 19. Parents are responsible for the conduct and behaviour of their children at all times, whilst attending the Feis within and around the venue.
- 20. Social Media Rule taking photos without parental permission is not permitted. Those who do not want to be photographed should make themselves known to the Feis Organiser.
- 21. Comhairle Laighean Child Safety Officer is Orla Nic Conuladh. Please contact her if you have any concerns in regard to child safety at the event. <u>DLPLeinster@gmall.com</u>.
- 22. Length of costume must adhere to principles of modesty and enable dancers to safely execute their movements and steps. Adjudicators who determine a costume to be too short or to lack modesty may ask a competitor to wear black tights (of a denier not less than 70 %) in order to continue in the competition.. for competitions adjudicated by a panel of more than on adjudicator, all adjudicators must agree to asking the dancer to wear tights.
- 23. CHANGING OF COSTUMES, DRESSING AND UNDRESSING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE HALLS OR PUBLIC AREAS.
- 24. An Coimisiun rules will apply of disputes arise that are not covered by the above rules.
- 25. Priomh Comortas is adjudicated by one adjudicator. Dancers perform a light and a heavy dance.
- 26. PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIP RULE FOR IRELAND EFFECTIVE FROM 1ST JANUARY 2022- A Preliminary Championship must be adjudicated by 3 or more Adjudicators and must consist of 2 rounds- 1 Light Round reel/slip jig, 1 Heavy Round Heavy Jig/Hornpipe. Preliminary Championships may run as a "stand alone" competition or may be incorporated into an Open Championship. Dancer may compete in and Open or a Preliminary Championship or both.
