Beginner:

Beginner is a competitor who has not taken Irish dancing lessons from a registered teacher prior to September 1st of previous year. A Beginner must move into Advanced Beginner the following year.

2 Steps, 2 Dancers at a time. Competitors in Beginner and Advanced Beginner must wear either a school costume or blouse & skirt. NO SOLO COSTUMES.

Future Champions:

Open to dancers who currently dance in Novice and Prizewinner levels. Must enter at least two grade level dances at the feis to be eligible. Must dance either REEL (48 bars) OR SLIP JIG (40 bars) and HORNPIPE (40 bars) OR JIG (48 bars) please specify on ENTRY FORM. All age groups will dance 2 at a time. This is not an actual championship competition but a way to practice doing championship length steps in front of three judges in preparation of dancing in solo championships at the North American Championships.

Full awards ceremony and special awards will be given for these competitions.

Adult Championship:

Open to all adult dancers who have either not taken Irish dance lessons as a juvenile and are at least 18 years old or may have taken Irish dance lessons as a juvenile, but have not competed in any competition, solo or team, feisanna or Oireachtas, except competitions specifically designated for adults within the past 5 years and must be 18 years old. Must dance REEL (40 bars) or SLIP JIG (32 bars) and HORNPIPE (32 bars) or TREBLE JIG (40 bars) and a traditional set piece from the approved list. Please specify your dances on the entry form. Dancers will dance 2 at a time.

NOTE: ORDER FOR CHAMPIONSHIP WILL BE DRAWN FOR YOU. SOFT SHOE WILL BE DANCED FIRST.

All age groups will dance 2 at a time on a split stage. ** Under 8 & 9 must do a traditional set.
